## MOTION FOR OUT OF TIME APPEAL

COMES NOW the above named Defendant, David Michael Clayboss, and moves this Court to grant him an Out of Time Appeal on the following grounds:

1. "A criminal defendant who has lost his right to appellate review of his conviction due to error of counsel is entitled to an out-of-time appeal." <u>Rowland v. State</u>, 264 Ga. 872, 452 S.E.2d 756 (1995).
